Compressed Air is referred to in many industries as the fourth utility, but unlike electricity, water, or gas, compressed air is generated on site rather than purchased from a separate entity. For this reason, it is important that compressed air systems include the necessary components both at the source and point of use areas to ensure reliable performance. Optimizing filtration and dryer technology at the compressed air source to meet ISO standards for air quality is key to ensuring consistent compressed air best practices and efficient operations.
